Volleyball: The College Volleyball team under the captaincy of International player Neha retained the Panjab University Inter College champion title for the year, 2022-23.

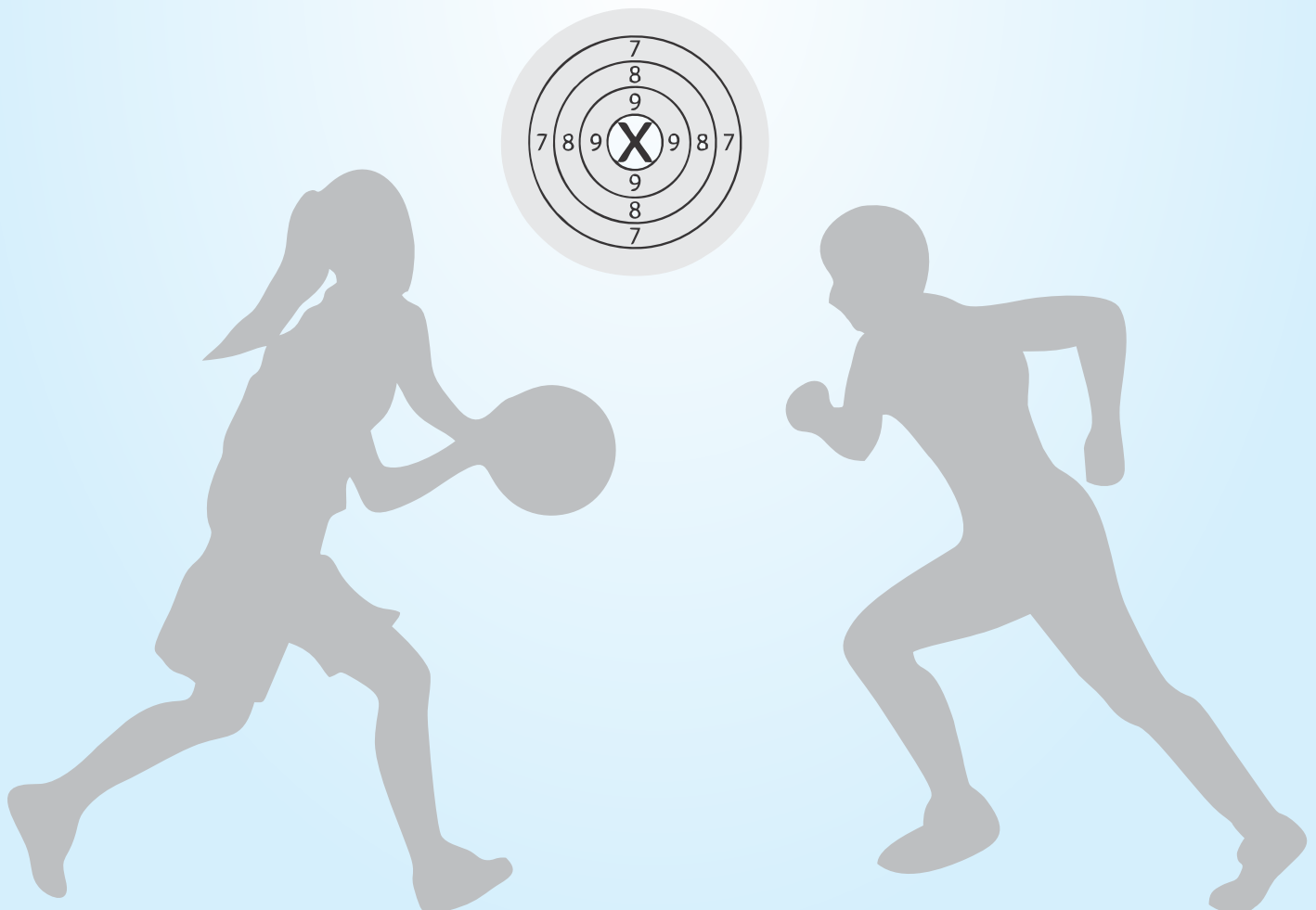
RUNNERS' UP POSITION

COLLEGE LIBRARY



The library of DAV College is well stocked and well equipped to fulfill the knowledge and information needs of the readers. Consistent efforts are always made to upgrade its all-round infrastructure. The Library provides conducive atmosphere and sufficient seating facility to its readers for browsing and relaxed reading. 24 computer systems have been installed in the digital corner of the library for our faculty members and the research scholars of our college.

Library is fully tech-enabled in operations and services. Library also provides access to e-resources through the databases like NLIST and J-Gate Social Sciences and Management to our esteemed faculty members and the college students. Library issues Unique Smart ID cum library cards to all the bonafide students and to all the staff members and the faculty of the college. It also provides back sets of Journals and Magazines, University Syllabi, Old Question papers of University exams. Data card printer, Information KIOSK has been installed in the library premises. The whole setup of RFID and RFID enabled Id cards have been incorporated in the library solely with the huge financial assistance from RUSA. This high end set up has made worthy readers more tech savvy in fulfilling their knowledge and informational needs.

To ensure students' active participation in the library, RAAH, the student-oriented Library Club of DAV College Sector-10 Chandigarh was launched on Dec. 30th, 2021 which stands for Read, Acquire, Achieve and Harmonize, the mantras for a progressive and peaceful life. Various activities are held from time to time like book exhibitions, signature campaign and training workshops on knowledge-based themes. Library is marching ahead in the mission of providing reader friendly ambience and services.

LAL CHAND RESEARCH LIBRARY:

Another landmark feature of our college is Lal Chand Research Library which has completed 100 years of its existence. The library was established in 1917 in Lahore by the DAV College Management Trust and Society after the name of RaiBahadurLal Chand, the first president of the Trust. The library today has a collection of almost 8,360 rare manuscripts. Apart from the manuscripts, as many as 10,303 rare books are also part of the library's inventory. Detailed records of architectural drawings and measurements of monuments such as the TajMahal, the QutabMinar and the Golden Temple can also be found here. The staff at the library of D.A.V. College, Chandigarh has worked wonders with this archival treasure. With the aid of latest technology, we have succeeded in protecting and preserving this magnificent heritage. Many scholars from India and abroad have shown keen interest in these manuscripts and books. The sustenance of more than 100 years of this rare treasure of ancient knowledge owes its existence to the efforts of authorities and the team work and dedication of library staff. We work on the principle of preserving the heritage for posterity.

- ❑ Department of Botany, in collaboration with Department of Biotechnology, DAV College, Sector 10, Chandigarh, organised various events to mark International day for the Preservation of the Ozone Layer on 16th September 2022. Around 80 students participated in Poster Making and Caption Writing competitions on the theme -Global Cooperation to Protect Life on Earth.
- ❑ Plantation drive on 01st October 2022 in collaboration with State Bank of India included planting of fruit trees and medicinal plants, in the Girls' Hostels, DAV College.

- ❑ The Department of Botany took a unique initiative, by digitization the flora of the botanical garden, through a digital album, which is available for viewing on the college website. The department also installed QR codes of each plant of the botanical garden.
